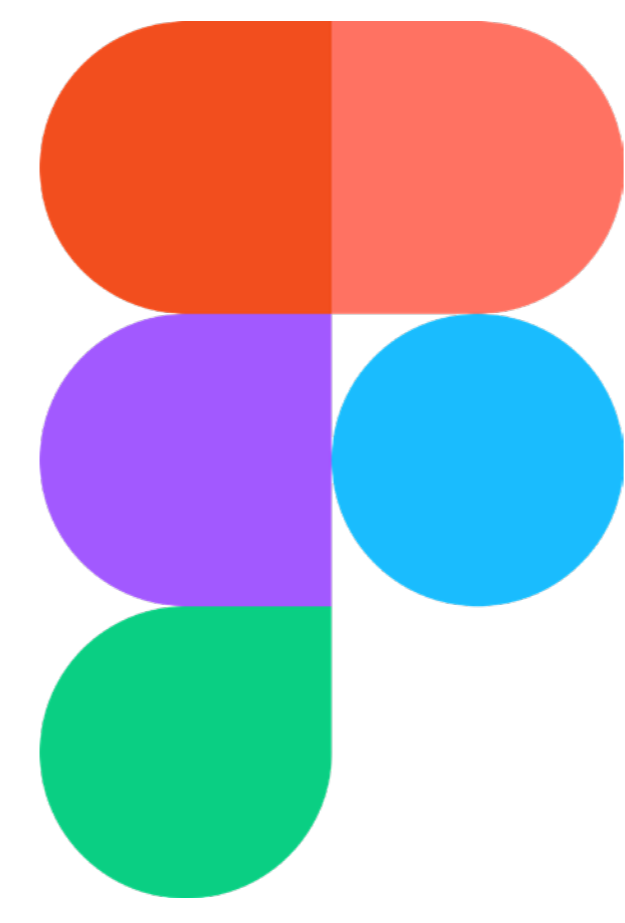

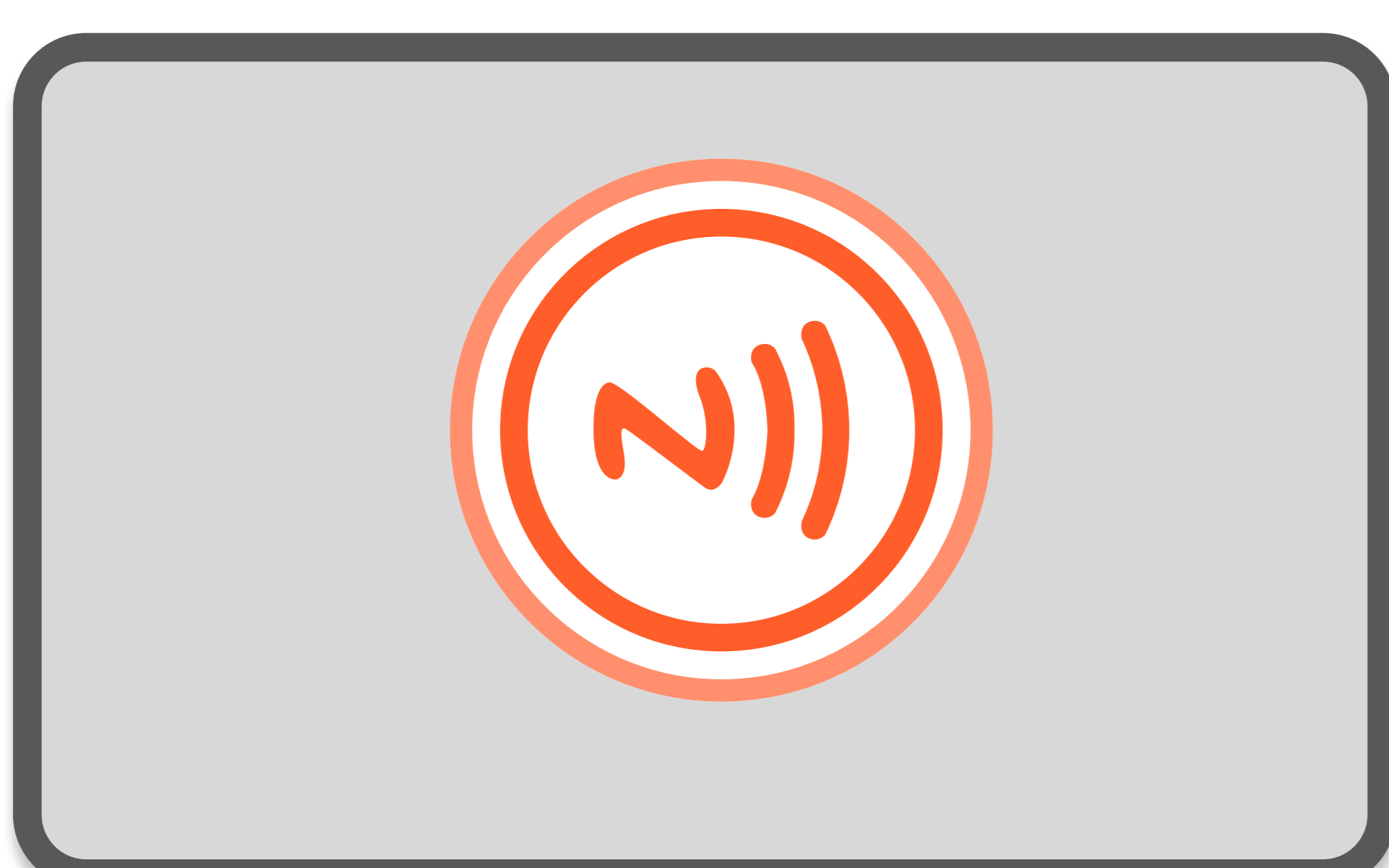

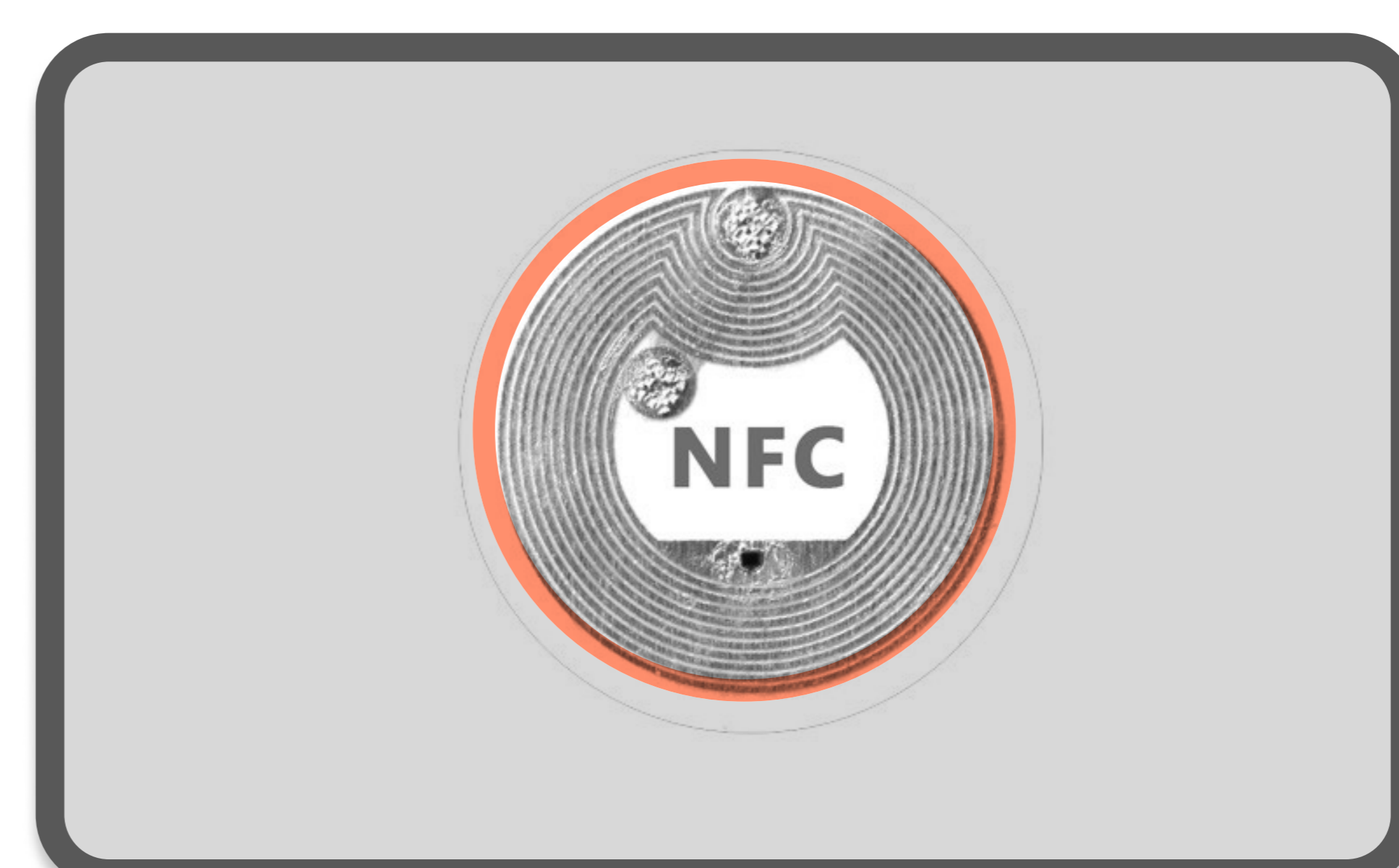

Stick NFC tags onto your cards

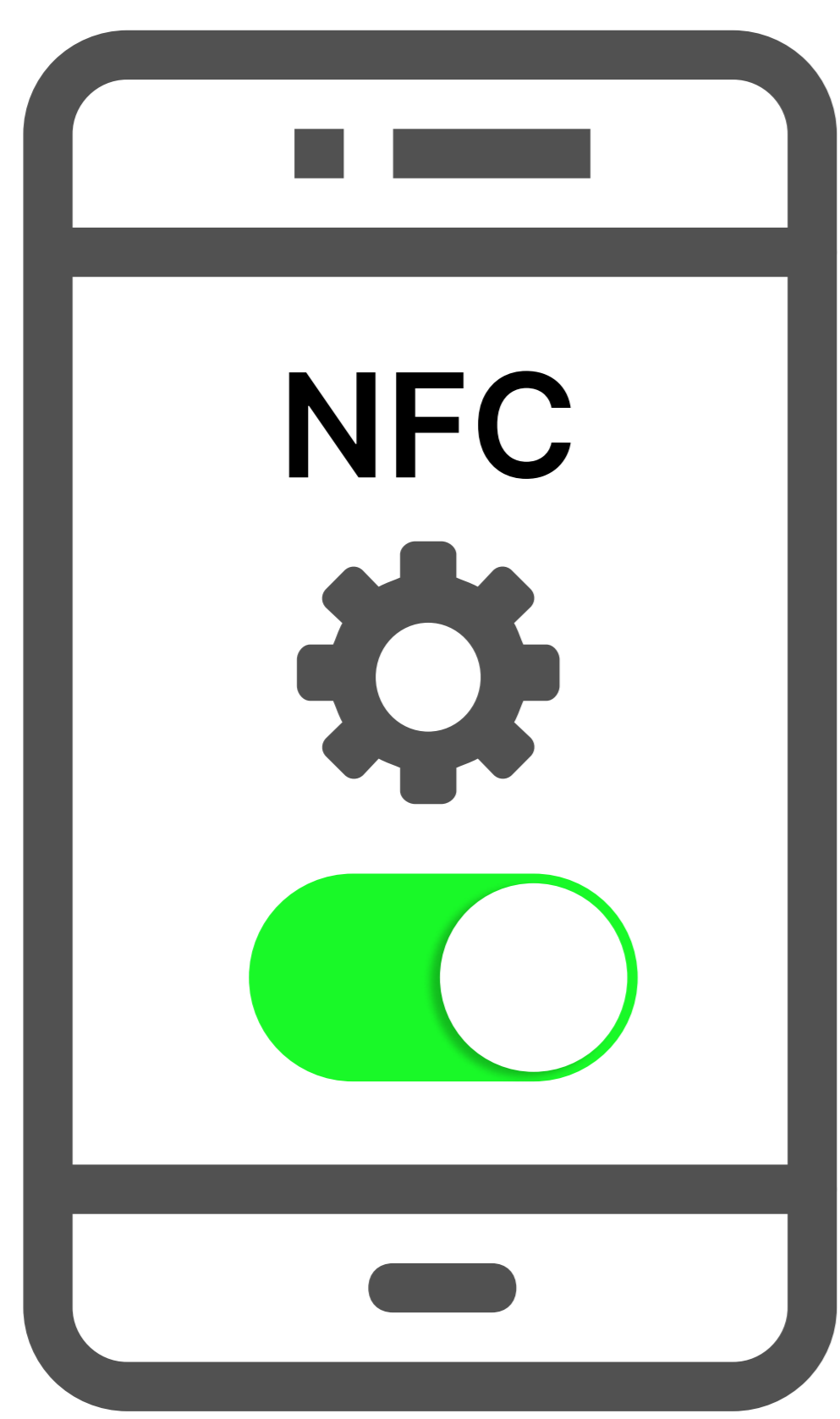

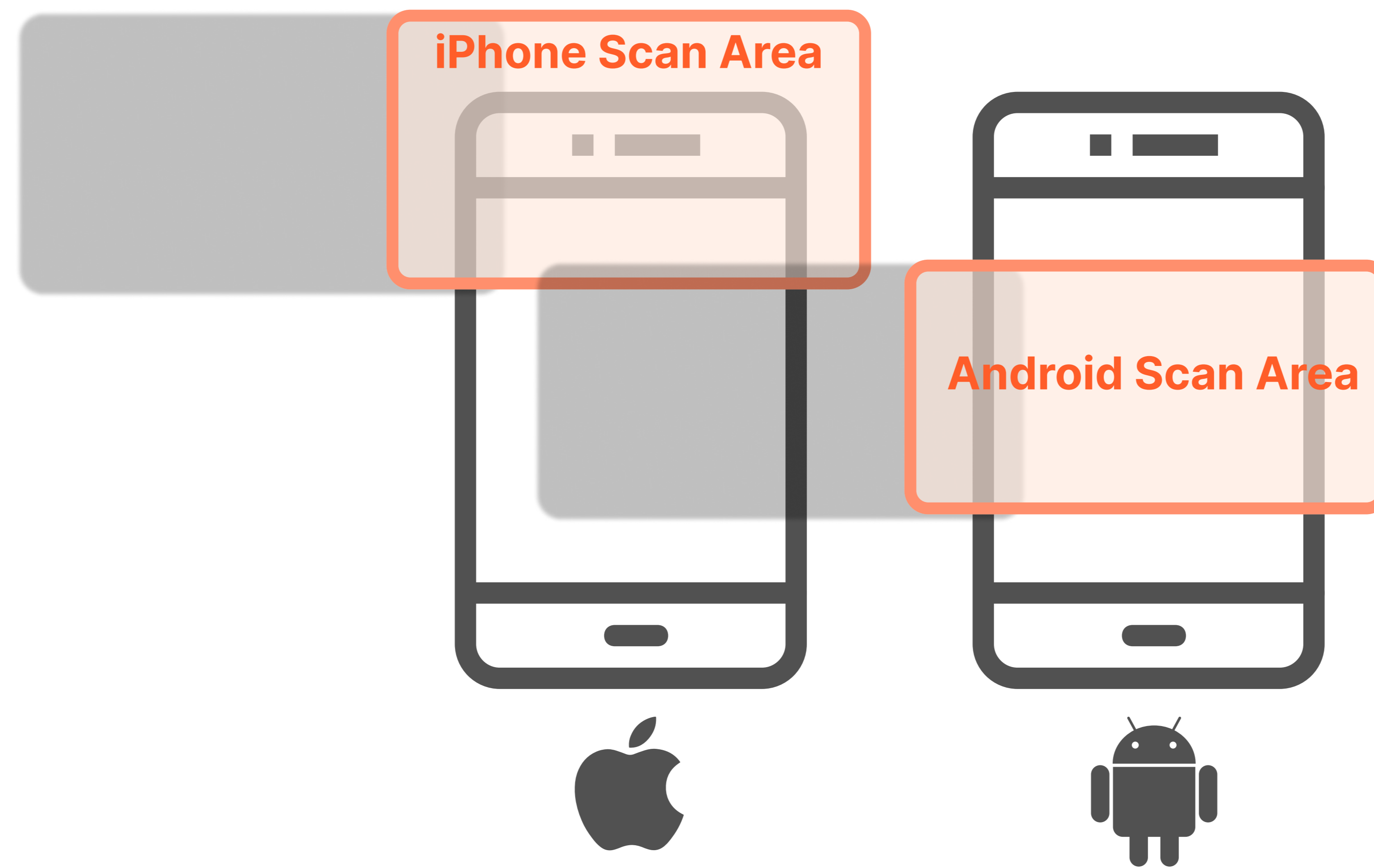
How to use the NFC Business Card?



1-Enable the NFC function

IOS: NFC is automatically enabled in Apple phones.

Android: Go to Settings and enable the NFC functions.



2-Find the NFC scan area

IOS: The NFC reader is located at the center-top-rear of Apple iPhones

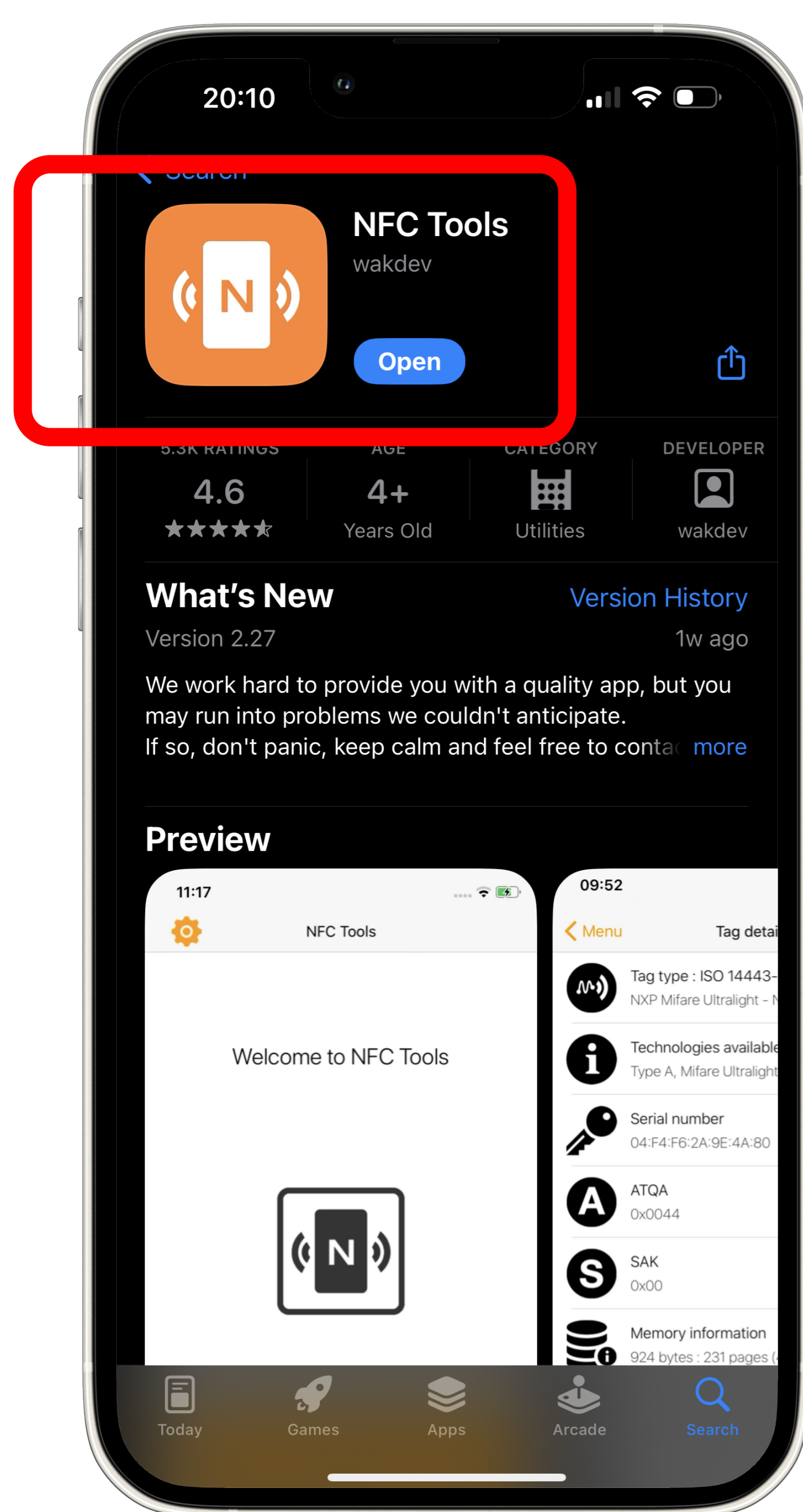
Android: Most androids have the NFC reader in the middle-back of phone.



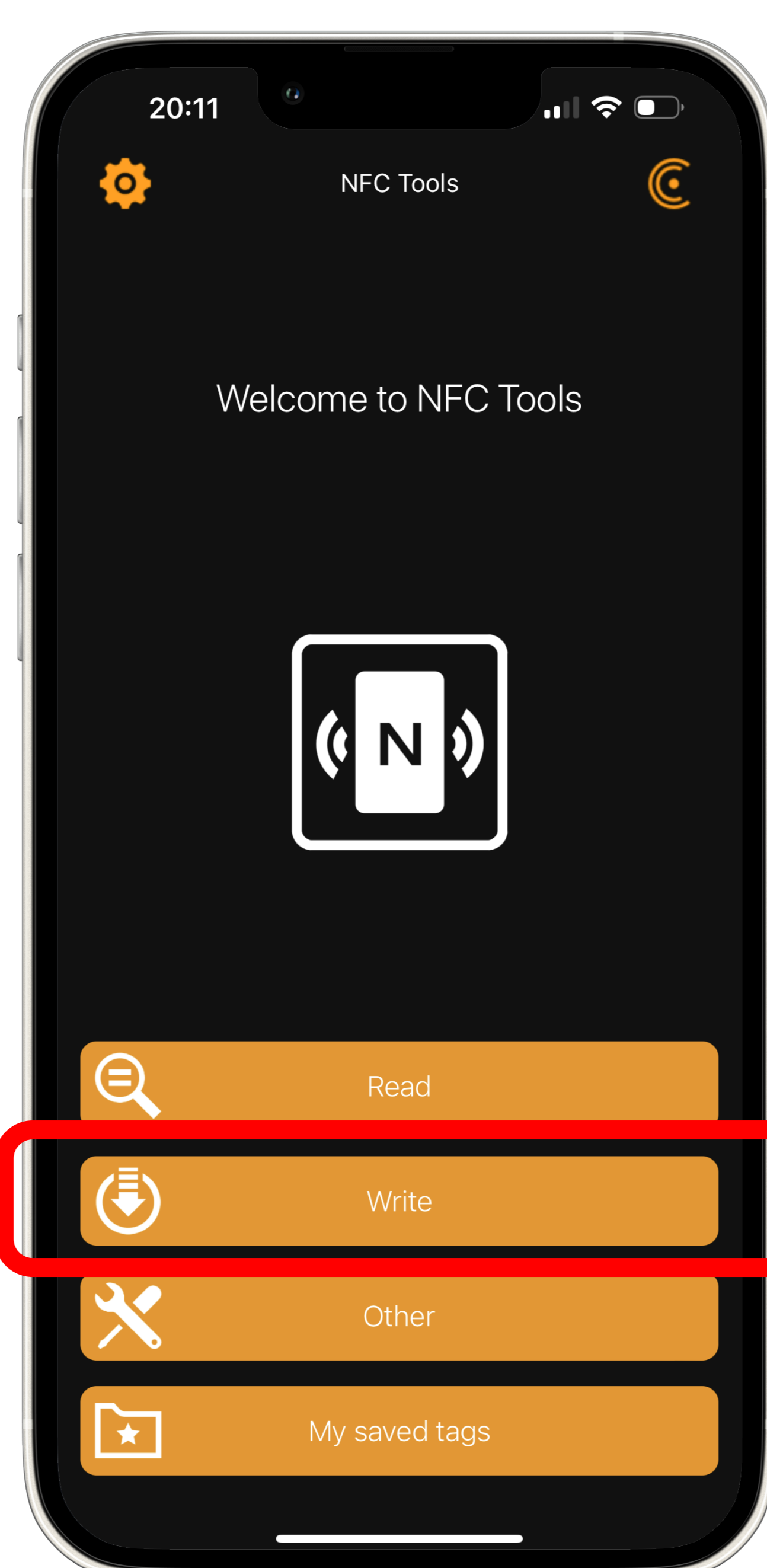
3-Tap the NFC Tag with your phone

After tap your phone to the NFC tag, the linked information should pop up on your screen.

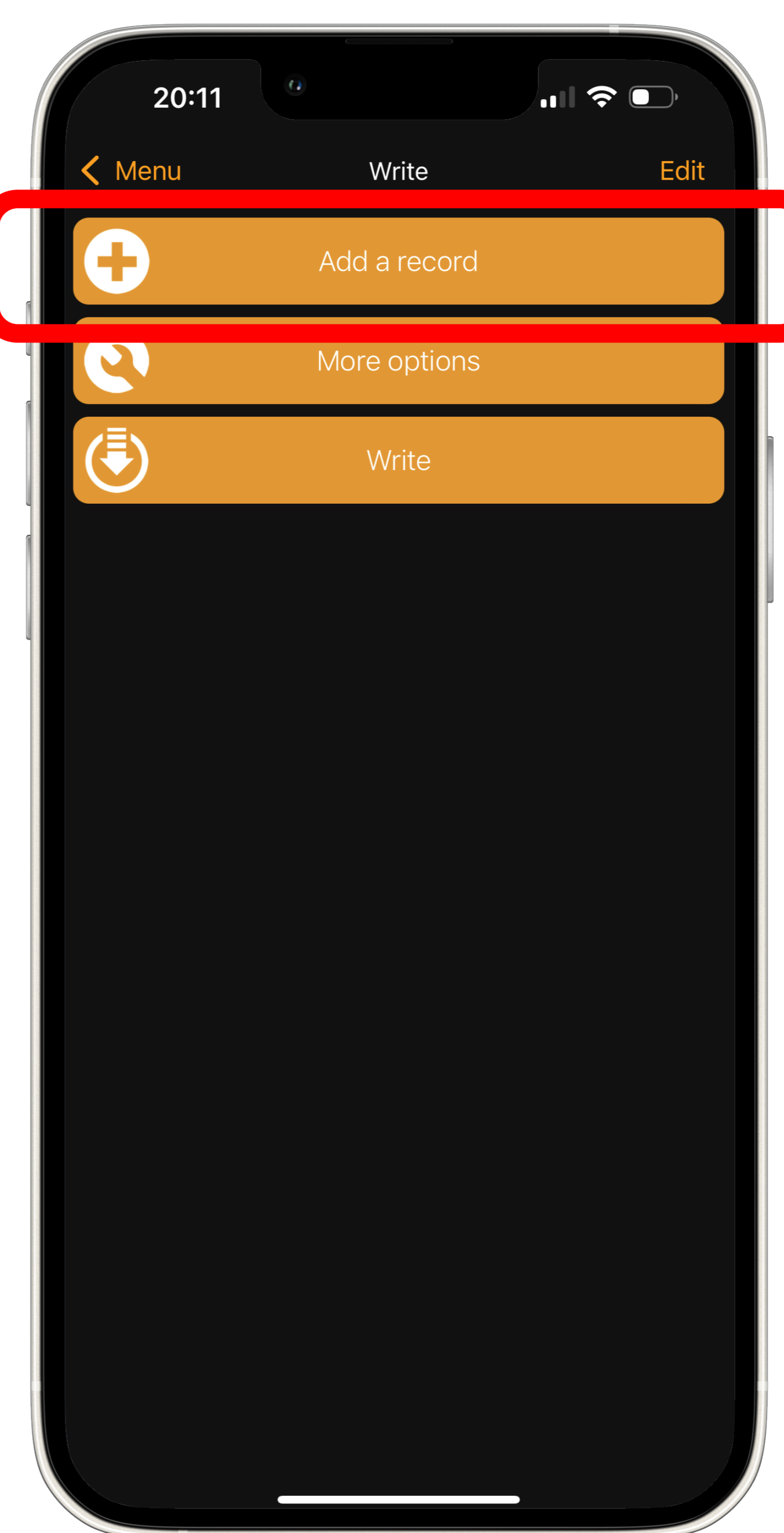
How to edit the information in the NFC tag?



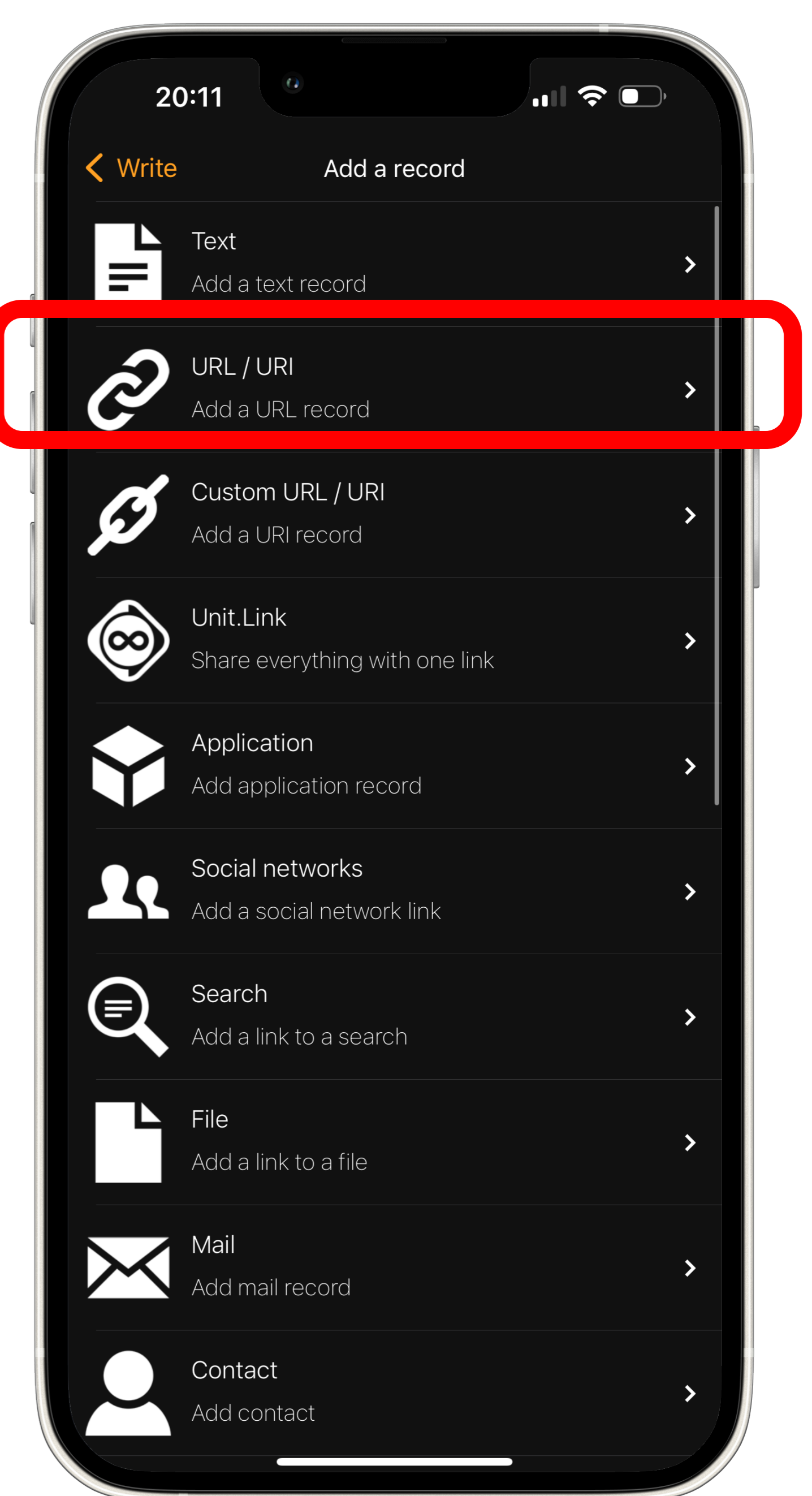
Download the "NFC Tools"



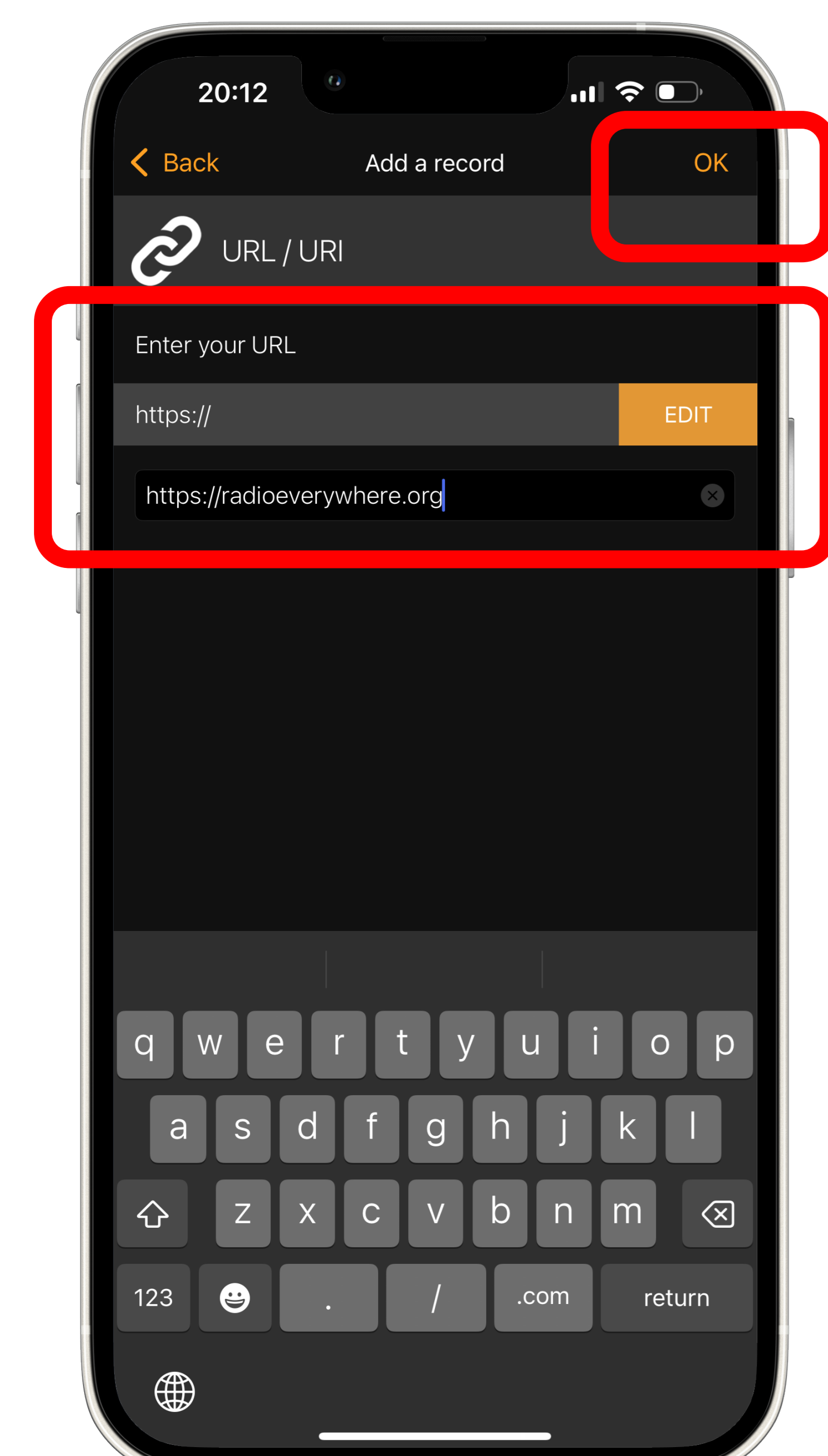
Click "Write"



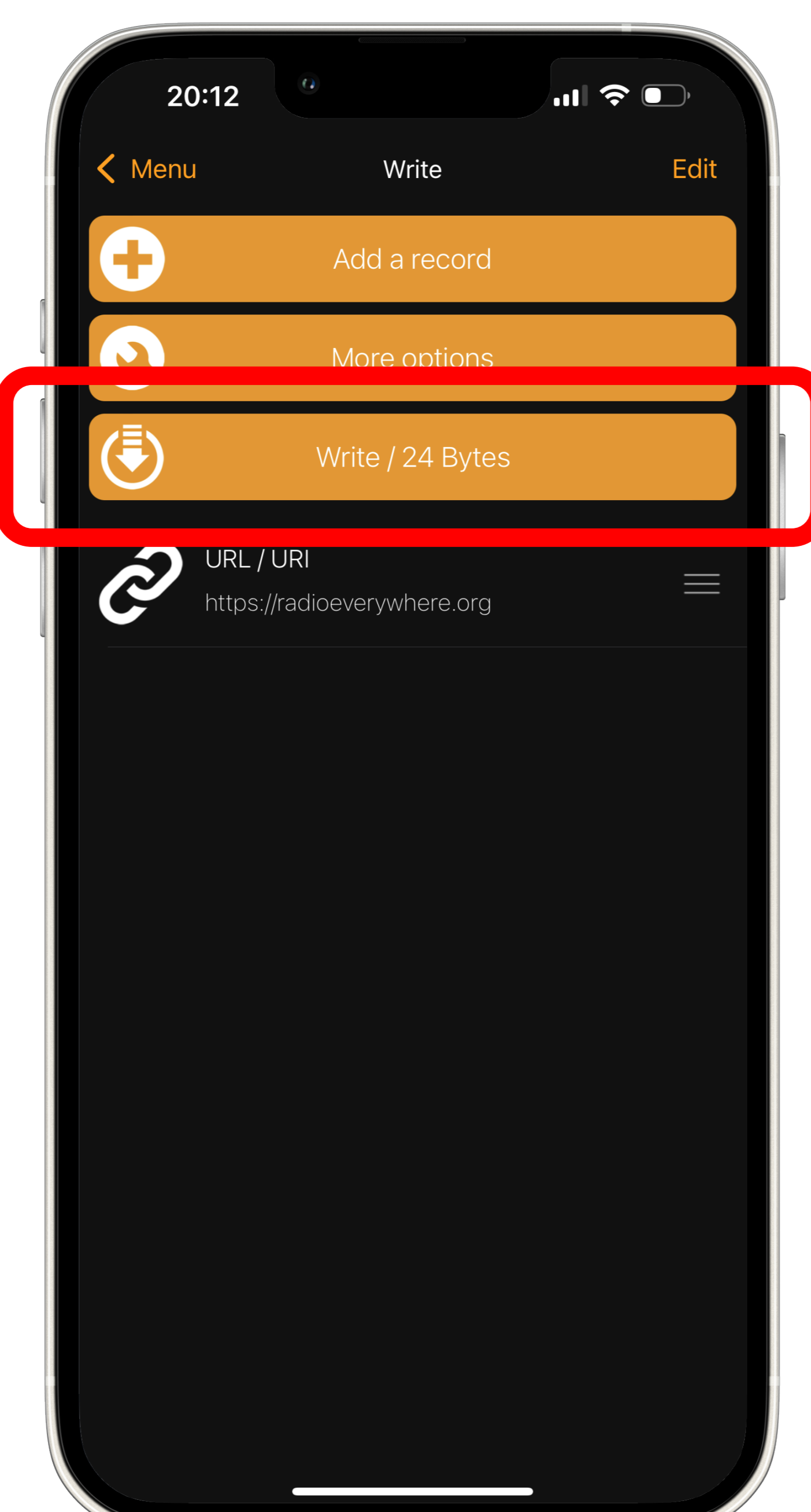
Click "Add a record"



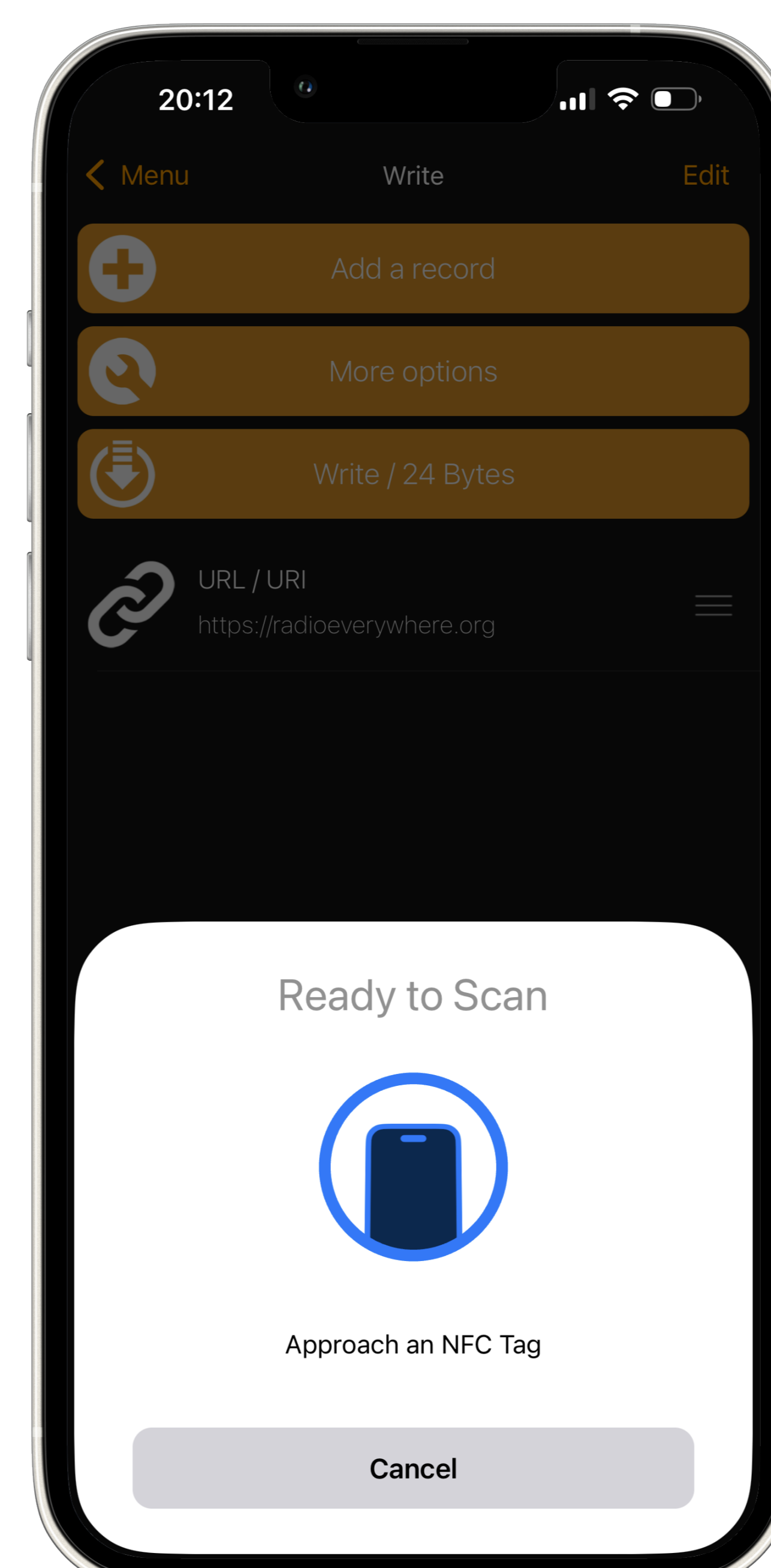
Click "URL/URI"



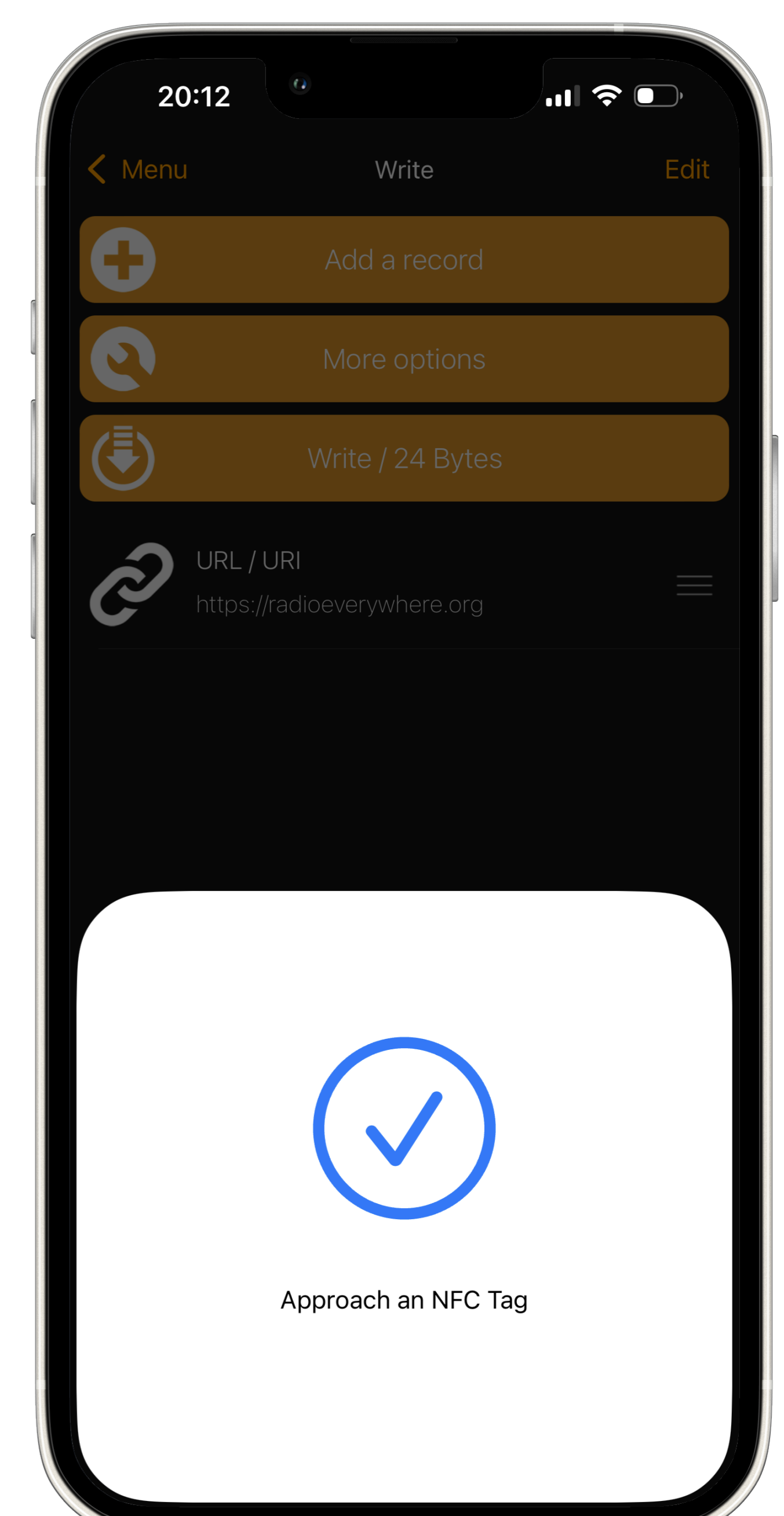
Type in the website URL, then click "OK"



Click "Write"



Put the NFC tag near the NFC scan area of your phone
